Form your business.		
1.1. Review formation options in Connecticut. $\square$		
Review the four types of legal structures available and choose the structure that		
suits your business's tax requirements.		
1.2. Name your business. $\square$		
Brainstorm name ideas, check name availability, and register it with the Secretary		
of State.		
1.3. Get an employer identification number. $\square$		
Apply for an EIN with the IRS.		
1.4. Register your business in Connecticut. $\square$		
Complete and file formation documents with the Connecticut Secretary of State.		
Sole proprietorships and general partnerships do not need to file any formal		
papers.		
1.5. Obtain necessary permits and licenses. $\square$		
Visit the Connecticut Licensing Info Center for more information on the types of		
permits and licenses you need to start your business.		
Register your business for taxes. $\square$		
2.1. Register for a sales or vendor's use tax. $\square$		
You can apply for sales tax, file, and make payments using the Taxpayer Service		
Center (TSC).		
2.2. Register for withholding tax. $\square$		



		You can file electronically with the Taxpayer Service Center (TSC) or you can
		download the registration form and hand it in to a local government office.
	2.3.	Register for corporation business tax. $\square$
		Find out if your business qualifies for corporation business tax. If liable, you'll need
		to file a Corporation Business Tax Return and make payments electronically by
		using the Taxpayer Service Center (TSC).
3.	Hir	e employees and report them to the state. $\square$
	3.1.	Go to the Connecticut Department of Labor Website. $\square$
		All employees must be reported to the New Hires division of the Department of
		Labor.
	3.2.	Obtain Workers' Compensation Insurance. $\square$
		Check out the State of Connecticut Workers' Compensation Commission website
		for more information on claims and rates.
	3.3.	Display mandatory posters in your place of business. $\square$
		Display state-mandated posters in populated workspaces.
